



ANNOUNCEMENT
of the
Singapore-Israel Joint Research Program

1. The Israel Science Foundation (ISF) and the National Research Foundation of Singapore (NRF) are launching a new program of joint funding for research proposals based on cooperation between Israeli and Singaporean researchers.
2. The aim of the program is to encourage research cooperation between Israeli and Singaporean scientists.
3. Each Foundation will finance the principal investigator of its country according to its rules. Grant budget will be equivalent or up to US\$100,000 per year for three years for each of the principal investigators (Singaporean and Israeli).
4. The joint program will include 5 submission cycles. Up to 6 proposals will be funded in each cycle.
5. Eligibility for submission and proposal funding will be determined according to the customary procedure of each Foundation.
6. One joint identical proposal, in English, will be submitted by the Israeli researcher and by the Singaporean researcher via the ISF on-line system. The first joint grant call will be in the fields of Computer Science, Mathematics, Earth Sciences, and is expected to be launched in November 2015.
7. The detailed guidelines will be published by each foundation in November 2015.
